SIKELIA NERO D'AVOLA

Sikelia is the name the ancient Greek sailors gave to Sicily, the island jewel of the Mediterranean. Nero d'Avola is Sicily's most important wine varietal. It means "black of Avola" (an ancient town), and offers a dark, lush wine that comes from its spicy, complex fruit. It's wonderful when young and fresh — with notes of sweet smoke, blackberry cobbler, and morello cherry.
